DOGS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

- 16-1. Running at Large. .
16-2. Enforcement by County Animal Warden.

§ 16-1. Running at Large.

- (a) No person shall permit any fowl or dog to be at large within the corporate limits of the town. For the purposes of this section, an animal may be deemed to be at large whenever it is off the property of its owner or custodian, and not under its owner's or custodian's immediate control.
- (b) Any owner or custodian violating paragraph (a) of this section shall be guilty of a class three misdemeanor and punished in accordance with § 1-4 of the town code.

§ 16-2. Enforcement by County Animal Warden. The animal warden of Rockingham County is authorized to enforce all dog laws applicable within the town. (See Code of Virginia. § 29-213.73 and the resolution and letter in the appendix to this title.)
