PUBLIC HEARING
AMENDMENT OF BUDGET**

Please take notice that on Tuesday, December 11, 2018, at 7:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers of the Bridgewater Community Center, 201 Green Street, Bridgewater, Virginia, the Bridgewater Town Council will receive public comments on proposed amendments to the Town's current (FY 2019) budget.

The amended budget includes adjustments to revenues and expenditures in several categories, notably the additional expenditure of \$1,200,000 for the construction of Sipe Center in FY 2019 and \$200,000 in construction costs in FY 2020, an additional \$68,600 in costs to be incurred in FY2019 for Riverwalk Phase I, an additional \$309,600 in costs incurred in FY 2019 for the Bruce Street and North Main Street sewer line projects, and \$62,500 expended for the purchase of 406 North Main Street. The budget amendment also includes \$1,400,000 in funds received from the loan for the Sipe Center, \$42,000 in grant funding for Riverwalk Phase I, and \$312,200 in loan funds received for the Bruce Street and North Main Street sewer line projects. The total increase of the FY 2019 budget is \$1,897,300.

The Town's intent is to amend the budget as described above. Affected persons are invited to appear at the hearing. Further details concerning the proposed budget amendment are available from the office of the Town Manager during normal business hours.
